¹The 「お」 in front is an honorific prefix, and 「様」 is used to show respect to the person called by putting it at the end of his/her name or nouns that represents people. Stripping this word of its honorific prefix and suffix, and we are left with the basic form of the word for “customer/guest”, which is 「きやく」「客」

²Literal translation is “origin”, but is used for where a person is from(country, city or place name).
