Lesson #16 - サ、シ、ス、セ、ソ

サ number of strokes: 3

Make sure this line curves inward.

シ number of strokes: 3

The directions of the lines are pretty important. If it helps you, draw a vertical line on the left side and start all three stroke from that line. They all start going the same direction, but then the last stroke takes a sharp turn.

ス number of strokes: 2

セ number of strokes: 2

It kind of looks similar to hiragana せ, doesn't it?

ソ number of strokes: 2

Both strokes start from the top. Again, like シ, the angles are very important in order to differentiate it from a character we'll learn later.
