つみ木	つみき	tsumiki	wooden blocks
木かげ	こかげ	kokage	shade under a tree
木ようび	もくようび	mokuyōbi	Thursday
木とう	ぼくとう	bokutō	wooden sword

## GRAMMAR

### Today's Target Kanji: 木

#### On-, Kun-yomi

On-yomi	<i>moku, boku</i>
Kun - yomi	<i>ki, ko</i>
Meaning	tree

#### Memorization Hint

The upper part of 木 indicates “branches” and the lower part indicates “roots.”

#### Sample Words and Phrases

ki	つみ木	<i>tsumi ki</i>	wooden blocks
ko	木かげ	<i>ko kage</i>	shade under a tree
moku	木ようび	<i>moku yōbi</i>	Thursday
boku	木とう	<i>boku tō</i>	wooden sword
