舌たらず	したたらず	shitatarazu	speak with a lisp
まき舌	まきじた	makijita	rolled tongue

GRAMMAR

Today's Target Kanji: 舌

On-, Kun-yomi

On-yomi	<i>zetsu</i>
Kun - yomi	<i>shita, jita</i>
Meaning	tongue

Memorization Hint

"千": means "thousand"

"口": means "mouth."

Notes regarding character

So to hold your tongue, you need to shut thousands of mouths.
